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# Further Education and Training Certificate: Early Childhood Development Level 4

#### Introduction

A wide body of research, including research from the World Health Organisation, points to early childhood as being the most important phase for overall development of an individual's intelligence, personality and social behaviour. The effects of neglect in these formative years can be cumulative and lasting.

The Further Education and Training Certificate: Early Childhood Development will enable you to facilitate allround development of young children in a manner that is sensitive to culture and individual needs (including special needs). It will also enable you to provide quality early childhood development services for children in a variety of contexts, including community-based services, ECD centres, at home and in institutions.

# Who should attend

This qualification provides a means for formal recognition of those who are already practicing in the field, without ECD qualifications, as well as for those who wish to enter the field.

#### **Entry Requirements**

- Communication and mathematical literacy at NQF Level 3 (Grade 11) or equivalent
- Second language at NQF Level 2 (Grade 10) or equivalent

#### **Training Breakdown**

This qualification runs over a period of one year with at least 25 days of training. Learners also have additional access to mentors and work groups to assist in the completion of the activities.
