The National Certificate: Specialist Hygiene and Cleaning Services, Level 2, is a practical occupational qualification aimed at individuals working in hygiene and cleaning services.

The programme is the second in a learning pathway for those who have completed the GETC: Hygiene and Cleaning at NQF Level 1 and it builds on the entry level skills and knowledge gained, It focuses on developing further skills to offer quality service and professionalism in a range of cleaning positions across industries.

It offers articulation into other related fields within cleaning services as well as entry to level 3 qualifications in allied industries.

Target Audience

The qualification is suitable for individuals who are working in the broad hygiene and cleaning industry and want to advance their careers within the sector.

Cleaners, team leaders and supervisors working in hospitality, healthcare, industrial and textile cleaning and manufacturing and allied industries will benefit from the programme.

Elective Modules

- Clean carpets using the wet extraction method
- Vacuum clean dry and wet surfaces
- Apply basic micro-biological principles in cleaning
- Clean wards and medium-risk, high-risk and isolation patient areas
- Maintain batteries in automatic scrubber-driers and auto sweepers
- Scrub hard and resilient floors using a battery-operated and mains-operated automatic scrubber-drier
- Strip and seal hard and resilient floors using a water-based sealing product





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
