Introduction

The National Certificate: Freight Handling, level 3, is an occupationally-based foundation qualification aimed at individuals working in freight handling.

It offers broad theoretical understanding and practical application based skills in the principles of freight handling, the structure of supply chain within the transport sector and handling freight responsibly and safely according to health, safety, environmental and security legislation and company practices.

The qualification offers career entry and learning progression for those wanting to work in the freight handling sector as well as in specialist areas of transport and logistics and freight forwarding and clearing. It can be used to gain entry into qualifications at an NQF level 4.

Target Audience

This programme is aimed at employed or unemployed individuals wanting to enter the industry and work in freight logistics, packing, handling and securing freight, transport, warehousing and distribution.

Entry Requirements

- Competency in Communication (English) at NQF Level 2.
- Competency in Mathematical Literacy at NQF Level 2.

Workplace Requirements

- Access to appropriate workplace environments in the transport sector specifically in warehousing and distribution environments.
- Active support by a mentor or supervisor.
- Access to a PC, software and the internet.
