Introduction

The National Certificate: Professional Driving is an occupationally based programme for drivers carrying freight or passengers.

The qualification is aimed at drivers seeking a formal qualification and wanting to become more professional, productive and well-rounded individuals with a range of skills including driving, transport operations, planning road transport delivery, customer service and general business understanding.

The qualification builds on light vehicle driving and offers career and learning progression for those working` in the commercial road transport industry as drivers. It can be used to gain entry into qualifications at an NQF level 4.

Target Audience

The qualification is aimed at individuals already working in the commercial road transport industry as drivers or those wishing to enter the sector.

Drivers transporting general freight and passengers and providing courier services will benefit from this programme.

Entry Requirements

- Competency in Communication (English) at NQF Level 2.
- Competency in Mathematical Literacy at NQF Level 2.
- A basic drivers' licence and Professional Driving Permit (PDP).

Workplace Requirements

- Access to appropriate workplace environments or already working in the transport sector.
- Access to a company vehicle.
- Active support by a mentor or supervisor.
- Access to a PC, software and the internet.
