

Introduction

The accredited Skills Programme: Shelf Filler (General), NQF level 2, is an entry level occupational programme for new entrants to the wholesale and retail sector.

It covers knowledge and practical skills in different W&R marketing segments, customer profiles, target markets and the buying habits of the industry, the different functional areas of a business in terms of stock and cash flow and applicable legislation.

Delegates will also cover subject areas such as completing basic income statements, identifying and explaining the types of expenses in a W&R outlet and shrinkage and loss. Maintaining a safe and secure work environment, avoiding accidents, the Occupational Health and Safety Act and emergency procedures form an integral part of this skills programme.

The programme can be used to articulate into the NC: Wholesale and Retail Operations.

Target Audience

The skills programme is aimed primarily at individuals entering the wholesale and retail sector as shelf fillers and packers.

Entry Requirements

- Competence in Mathematical Literacy at NQF Level 1.
- Competence in Communication at NQF level 1.
