

#### Introduction

The National Certificate: Wholesale and Retail Distribution, level 2, is an entry level occupational qualification. It is aimed at individuals working in distribution in the wholesale and retail sector and in mail order retail, in different types and sizes of organisations and SMME.

It offers a solid foundation in the main areas of wholesale and retail distribution, maintaining, counting, moving and packing stock, maintaining a safe and secure environment, the important concepts of the industry and communication and numeracy.

The qualification offers a career path and progression to level 3 qualifications in other areas of Wholesale and Retail Distribution and business.

## Target Audience

The programme is aimed at individuals entering the industry and those already working in wholesale and retail distribution, seeking a formal qualification.

It prepares delegates for work in wholesale, distribution centres, retail and mail order retail. It is also suitable for individuals working in broader business and transport and logistics-related environments in administration, warehousing and storage.
