Cleaning Support Services is a sub-portfolio within Health, Safety and Hygiene that offers a selection of practical, accredited cleaning-related Unit Standards that can be run individually or in combination, to suit delegate requirements.

The programme is aimed at cleaners and supervisors working in cleaning services and support roles in sectors including business, medical facilities, pharmaceutical, hospitality food and beverage services and manufacturing.

Topics include cleaning hard floors and carpeted floors, cleaning windows and above floor surfaces, vacuuming dry services.

- Clean above the floor surfaces
- Perform end of task procedures after cleaning floor surfaces

#### **Clean Windows**

- Clean windows

#### **Vacuum Dry Surfaces**

- Spot mop floors
   Wet mon floors
- Perform end of task procedures after wet mopping floors

#### Clean Floors Using a Single Disc Machine

- Plan and prepare to clean floors using a single disc machine
- Buff floors
- Scrub floors
- Perform end of task duties after maintaining floors with a single disc machine
