Introduction

This occupational short programme is unit standard based and aimed at cleaners working in commercial, domestic and industrial cleaning environments.

The programme is practical and provides cleaning services employees with the opportunity to carry out their functions more professionally and effectively. It covers two broad subject areas, vacuum cleaning wet surfaces and stripping and sealing hard floors.

Delegates will learn how to use a vacuum cleaner and accessories to clean different wet floor surfaces, follow a range of cleaning and safety procedures, remove high foam liquids from floors, prepare hard floors for stripping, manual stripping, wet and dry stripping, resealing floors and following end-of-task activities after sealing is complete.

The programme can be used to articulate into the GETC: Hygiene and Cleaning.

This course is suitable for cleaners working in commercial, industrial, pharmaceutical, food handling, domestic and health care cleaning environments.
