Introduction

Based on SAQA unit standards, these two practical programmes will give individuals introductory and intermediate skills in working with MS PowerPoint.

Level 1 is for individuals who are new to PowerPoint or who have received little formal training. Delegates will learn how to plan, produce, use and evaluate presentations using a Graphical User Interface (GUI)based application.

Level 2 builds on level 1 skills and is for individuals who have been using PowerPoint at an intermediate level and need additional skills on the application's features. It covers creating graphs, organisational charts and drawings, importing images and objects and manipulating them, using animations and transitions and customising Master Slides in presentations.

Target Audience

Level 1 is aimed at individuals who need basic knowledge to create and produce MS PowerPoint presentations.

Level 2 is aimed at individuals who need intermediate knowledge to enhance MS PowerPoint presentations by using features like graphs, charts, images and animations.

Entry Requirements

- Mathematical and Communication competency at NQF Level 1 (MS L1) and NQF level 2 (MS L2).
- The ability to operate a personal computer at NQF Level 1 (MS L1), successful pass of Level 1 programme outcomes (MS L2).

Additional Requirements

- Access to a PC, software and the internet for course work.
- Internet and bandwidth to accommodate virtual, facilitator-led sessions.

MS PowerPoint Level 1: Use A Graphical User Interface (GUI)-based Presentation Application To Prepare And Produce A Presentation According To A Given Brief

- Prepare and produce a presentation according to a specified brief

- Create a graph in a presentation
- Create an organisational chart in a presentation
- Create a drawing in a presentation
- Import images into a presentation
- Images and objects are manipulated in a presentation
- Animation effects and transitions are applied or added to a presentation
- Master slides are customised within a presentation
